EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

President, Susy Stovin: Called the meeting to order

Treasurer, Brian Ruediger: "The Historic Brookhaven Neighborhood Association continues its trend of financial soundness, with adequate funds to meet its current year budget and anticipated expenses." More specific HBNA financial information is available from the treasurer.

Secretary, Anne Culberson: February Minutes were distributed and approved unanimously by vote.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Cameras, Tom Mallory: Committee is currently getting approval for camera signage from The Atlanta Public Works Dept. Committee will gather data for first quarter that includes missing persons, wanted persons, and stolen vehicles.

Communications, Maribett Varner, Committee reports neighborhood has distributed newsletters and membership directory. Mark Roberts reports, 748 households have joined HBNA this year.

Beautification, Carole Simpson: Committee reports that benches have arrived for micro parks and green spaces and will be placed soon, Vermont Park has received a grant of \$2600 from Park Pride. Club Estates Garden Club will donate \$5000 to Vermont Park beautification. The Beautification Committee welcomes new committee members.

Transportation, Wade Copeland: Committee reports, new Crawl Y'all campaign to reduce speeding. Neighbors are asked to go 24 mph throughout the neighborhood and make a full stop. Shelby Cobb is working to get new striping and white lines where needed at intersections and

stop signs. White lines have been redrawn at the intersection of Capital City Lane and West Brookhaven. The signage and intersection at the park at Brookhaven and West Brookhaven was discussed for safety. Beginning in April, Shelby Cobb will chair transportation with assistance of Gay Colyer.

Filming: Gene Hooff, Gene reported, recent filming on Narmore. HBNA was granted \$2500 for filming.

Events, Rebecca Harvill, Committee plans to have a street party this fall.
