EXECUTIVE BOARD:

President, Susy Stovin: Susy called meeting to order at 8:00 am.

Treasurer, Brian Ruediger: Brian states, "The Historic Brookhaven Association continues in "Good Health". The Association is able to meet all current and anticipated expenses at this time."

Secretary, Anne Culberson: The April Minutes were distributed by email and approved by vote in the May meeting.

COMMITTEES:

Transportation, Shelby Cobb: Shelby discussed Zoom calls with City of Atlanta, Watershed Management. The city presented the drainage project with neighbors on Club Drive, Vermont Road and Winall Down Road. Two informational meetings were presented to neighbors. The DWM sent pdfs of the Zoom meetings to everyone who registered. The city representatives are available by appointment for questions or site visits. Some concerns expressed by residents regarding the city's preference for larger concrete drains as well as drainage from Stovall Blvd. to Vermont Road to Winall Down Road. The Zoom meetings were informative and positive. Other future issues to discuss in more detail are the paving of Winall Down Road and possible corrective paving on Vermont Road. The City's Adopt A Drain program will be explained in more detail as well. Shelby is available for updates and a more detailed report.

Cameras, Tom Mallory: Tom is working with FLOCK to produce clearer photos, greater sensitivity of images and better LPR data. The cameras currently read license plates. The cameras capture license plate data that is transmitted to the police for crime alerts, such as stolen license plates, stolen autos and missing or wanted persons. More signage is planned to alert persons of security cameras.

Communications, Maribett Varner: Maribett states August 1 is the deadline for the fall or September newsletter.

CME, Carole Simpson: Carole reports, the benches are delivered to the neighborhood parks. Much praise for the park benches by neighbors!
Work at Vermont Park is almost complete.

Events, Rebecca Harvill: The fall street party is being planned for September 17 or October 1.

Zoning, Cathy Boston: Cathy discussed the active Brookhaven real estate market. There is one home on Club Drive that received a variance to build closer to the street.
